## 'I don't do this to pay the bills, but to help people'

**F**rom as far back as I can remember, ghosts, ghouls, and things that go bump in the night have fascinated me!

Not surprising really, having a clairvoyant as a mum.

I didn't know it – but Mum had passed her 'gift' onto me. I found that out in my teens,

when I began experimenting with crystals and tarot cards, before concentrating my remote viewing... RV for short.

I heard about it in the 1990s when it was being used by the US military to help them with their spying activities.

If someone, say, wants to find a missing relative, they

write it down on a piece of paper, mark it with the date, and then keep it a secret.

They then instruct me to begin RV. I get no more information from them!

I visualise the paper, then write down what comes into my mind. I've predicted sporting outcomes and *Big Brother* winners before!

It's always done it blind – I never know what the question is – which makes getting the answer even more amazing.

But sometimes I use RV in very serious situations. I work for a group called

*'The car where I died...'  
That's right, I was speaking to the dead, could see and feel everything as if I was there.  
Now it was time to tell his*

*I knew how much comfort my second sight could give, even if it didn't actually solve the case.  
That's why I did it.  
But it hadn't always been this*

Find Me which is for people who've lost loved ones.

Over the past 13 years, I've worked on nearly 60 cases.

I'm not doing this for the money – I work as a graphic designer to pay the bills...

I do it to help people, that's worth more than anything to me...
