## Why:

- Remember to constantly ask and explore
- If you get data explore it?
- If a word, phrase or piece of data comes through which is not part of your day-today language highlight this and come back to it later and explore it but probing or breaking it down – it may be important.
- If things get complex ask 'what are you trying to show me?'
- Probe everything; try to squeeze as much data as you can from every flow.

# Sketching:

Use these 'cues' to move around & sketch the target

- Move to the optimum position & sketch the target in detail
- Move above the target & sketch in detail
- Move to the primary part of the target & sketch this in detail
- Pull away from the target to a position where the entire target can be seen & sketch.

### Movements:

- Move to the **CENTER** of the target & describe.
- Move **ABOVE** the target & describe in detail
- Move to the **TAKSERS** objective at the target & describe in detail
- Move to the **PRIMARY** part of the target & describe in detail

Pull **AWAY** from the target to a position where the entire target can be seen & describe.
