This four-meter resolution, color image of Bora Bora (meaning "First Born") was collected by Space Imaging's IKONOS satellite on Oct. 25, 2001. The image centers on Bora Bora's main island, referred to as "The Marvelous Island," located 240 kilometers northwest of Tahiti. More than seven million years old, the island is protected by a coral reef with only one navigable inlet seen on the west side of the image. Other features include Matira beach and it's world-famous lagoon, the principal village of Vaitape, across from the inlet, and a 32-kilometer road circling the island. This image could be used for multiple applications including assessing the area for new construction opportunities, identifying coral reef patterns to protect from environmental hazards, monitoring infrastructure projects and tourism
