What impact, if any, can telepathic interference have on the process of remote viewing?

Can the beliefs or intentions of a tasker, monitor, and viewers significantly influence the result of an operational RV session, even under blind conditions?

The target background

I gave this target to a beginning/intermediate level remote viewing class in which students could use crv or free style rv methods. At the time, I was struggling with confusion and neurological difficulties after being bitten by a black widow spider. I believed the target to be a real place and it came up on travel websites.

Only when I tried to locate the address for dowsing feedback did I realize it was never built and was merely a concept.

Upon discovering my mistake, I expected sessions to be mostly misses. Much to my surprise students did seem to connect with the conceptual target.

What I did notice was a lack of strong stage 3 sketches.





In 2008 and later presented at IRVA in 2009, The Hawaii Remote Viewers Guild ran a remote viewing experiment called Tanner Dam.

Ten remote viewers from three different schools and methodologies (SRV, CRV, HRVG) worked the target.

All the remote viewers accurately and in great detail described the target...

The only problem is the target did not actually exist.

Dick Allgire - I sat down with some art paper and pens and I drew a fictitious place. I spent hours, days, weeks, months bringing this to life.

It's called TANNER DAM. It's an earth fill dam on a small river in a mountainous region.

I began sketching my dam and the lake behind it. The dam is 212 feet high, 1015 feet across. The lake Tanner Lake, is 3 ½ miles long and almost a mile and a half wide at it's widest point. There are campgrounds on the west side, cabins on the east shore. There's a concession stand and boat ramp and sailboat marina.

I hired an artist and described the place to him, showed him the sketches of it, paid him to paint it as he saw it.



For the past decade this great but disturbing experiment, has always been in the back of my mind – because frankly it didn't make sense to me.

Its something that has highlighted for me the need to re-examine Remote Viewing and the very real need to try to find the core of its mechanism because an element of telepathy just cannot be discounted.

Which is why, when discussing this presentation with John and Pam, I decided to also try a very quick and dirty example of my own on this topic.

On 26 May, 2017 on my remote viewing facebook group that has over 3,319 members, I asked if people would contribute RV sessions for a small experiment.

I had ten people respond and send me their data.

Now, like the Tanner Dam experiment from 2008 my target too did not physically exist.

In fact probably less so than the HRVG experiment because I didn't even get an artist painting made – which could be viewed as we all know that sometimes viewers view the feedback.

My experimental target – which only exists in my mind and a brief description typed into notepad was;

2605-8811

OK so I am going to create a fictional target in my mind and this text pad only.

In the playing 'field' near to my house a circular grassed/green area with a cross shaped path in the middle, plus a waste bin. A UFO will land in the centre here, descending slowly from the sky.

A pyramid shaped UFO of 30 ft in height - glowing blue from the top. this will descend during a quiet day. It will leave a burnt/black patch underneath it.

Out of this will come a 8ft tall very thin, long armed being, who will communicate with me.

This being will be holding hands with a small, young girl wearing a blue dress, and with long blonde hair - her name is goldilocks (from goldilocks and three bears fame). She will smile at me but say nothing.


After 10 minutes, they will get back on board and the object will lift up. It will rise straight-up then will disappear in a flash of white light. No noise will be made other than the whoosh of air.

My intent is for the viewers to ONLY describe these fictional events that exist only in my mind and nothing more.


Data I expect:

circle with cross grass/green pyramid shape UFO/vehicle blue very tall skinny man blonde girl wearing blue/goldilocks. burnt/black grass/grass moving upwards/downwards whoosh noise


Pretty much all the participants describe to a greater and lesser degree: energy, UFO/vehicle or similarly triangle/pyramid shaped object. They describe up and down movement, whooshing noise and much more that fits a target that only exists in my imagination.














There are other interesting parts within the data that fit my imagination;

- 1. the shape of the real location I set this fiction within a square field in the middle of a Oval shape of houses, with a cross shaped path this shows up in the data
- 2. one or more life forms
- 3. One of the viewers, very early on in S1 picked up an AOL of 'teddy bear' maybe a nod towards my fictional Goldilocks character.



Of course this is all very experimental and not conclusive in any way.

But this the earlier HRVG experiment, and others does leave us with some very interesting questions.

What exactly is in use in remote viewing?

Is telepathy involved and if so to what extent?

Is telepathy a help or hindrance within remote viewing?

If Telepathy is involved or even if it is entanglement, where are the borders, for example:

If the viewers and taskers can somehow communicate, then is this all?, what about analysts?, what about future reviewers of the data?, where are the borders of interaction-where does it stop?
