Extra Feedback:

The discovery by Howard Carter in 1922 of the almost undisturbed tomb of Tutankhamun (who died around 1325 BCE) revealed the riches of the New Kingdom royal burials in the Valley of the Kings. Yet Tutankhamun was a young and obscure pharaoh. His fabulous treasures can only hint at those looted from the tombs of great kings like Ramesses II. The funeral mask of Tutankhamun was placed over the face of the young pharaoh. It contains 10 kilograms of gold.
